## Top spot for TV host

**MIKE GOLDMAN**, the host of Channel 10's *Big Brother Friday Night Live*, has bought into the Bucasia Beach resort, located about 10 kilometres north of Mackay at the start of the Whitsunday Passage. His \$1.6 million-plus outlay secures one of the 37 beach houses set to be developed under the Tempo Lifestyles brand on a one-hectare site. Construction of the resort is expected to start in June. After its scheduled late 2009 completion, his front-row, three-storey house will have ocean views. Developed by Archer

Consulting's **John Archer**, Bucasia Beach Resort and Spa will have 23 three-storey beach houses and 14 two-storey beach houses. Designed by **Christian Skou**, director of Croneskou Architecture Studios, its additional amenities will include a gourmet restaurant, bar and day spa. Interest from Sydney buyers around the booming resource-rich city of Mackay has been boosted since the launch of direct flights between Sydney and Mackay last February.

Prices at Bucasia Beach resort range from \$810,000 to \$1.85 million.
