Tempo is upbeat

THE tempo is nothing if not upbeat.

A Tempo Lifestyles Property Centre threw open its doors in Mackay last Wednesday, a month before construction is to begin on a Northern Beaches resort.

The \$50 million development will start construction in August, and the sales office has been moved from the Bucasia site in preparation.

Developer John Archer said it meant the company was "one

step closer to bringing a five-star resort to Mackay".

"The sales office will also give Mackay access to five-star properties overseas," Mr Archer said.

"This is a significant development for Mackay and it's crucial the development plan is presented in a clear manner, which is what the property centre will do.

"It's also for properties in Airlie Beach and elsewhere."

He added that the Archer

Property Group were developing a resort in Airlie that would overlook the currently under construction port.

The five-star resort at Bucasia will be the first project under the Tempo Lifestyles brand, being build on a one hectare site at Bucasia.

The new property centre features a display of the resort's beach houses and facilities, along with details on the Airlie Beach development.
